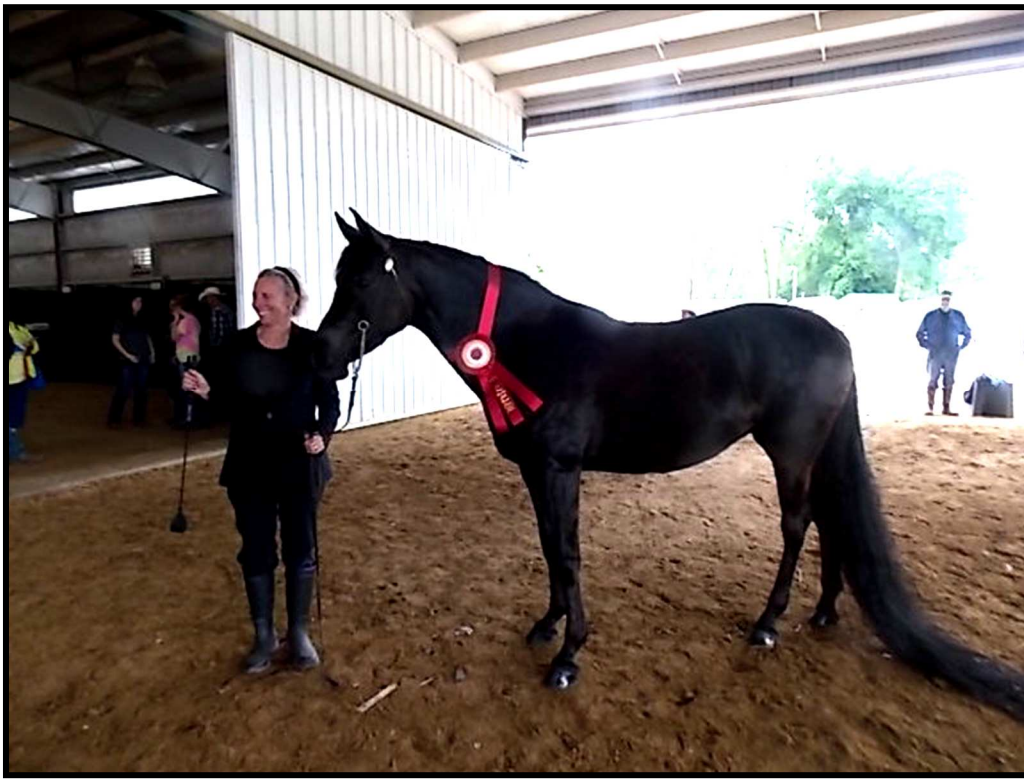
To all club members
